The highlights from Sewanhaka High School as follows:

- Representatives from local colleges visited senior English classes and conducted mock college interviews, along with the guidance counselors. Students' interview techniques were then critiqued by their peers. For many seniors this was the first "real interview" that they ever had.
- College reps from area schools have been conducting on-site interviews with our seniors. NYIT offered 17 students a total of \$776,000 in scholarships and St. John's University offered 15 students a total of \$689,000 in scholarships.
- Senior counselors are holding a "College Application Clinic" on Tuesdays and Thursdays after school. This process assists students who want to submit their applications on-line, edit their college essay or conduct a college search. Ms. Ferrigno mentioned that this was an excellent service that students should avail themselves to.
- Faculty and students donated 58 boxes of food and 30 turkeys to the St Vincent de Paul Food Pantry in the annual Thanksgiving Food Drive.
