Dear Alden Parents and Guardians,

It's hard to believe that we are approaching the end of the 3rd full week of school. Our scholars have settled into their routines and everyone seems to be enjoying the start of the new 2019-2020 school year.

I have some **very important SAFETY REMINDERS** to share. School is in session and it is important for each family to adhere to safe morning drop-offs and pick-ups. **PLEASE DO NOT STOP AND PARK ON CENTRAL AVENUE ON THE CURB IN FRONT OF THE SCHOOL. NOT ONLY IS IT UNSAFE FOR BOTH YOU AND YOUR CHILDREN BUT IT IS ILLEGAL AND YOU CAN BE TICKETED FOR DOING SO** (This information is listed inside of the Alden Terrace Parent Handbook). The school and district are not responsible for tickets that you may incur. The 5th precinct / Nassau County Police Department will continue to ensure the safety of all of our scholars and will continue to monitor the drop-offs and pick-ups.

School begins at 8:05am. Students may line up for grades K & 1 near the primary playground at 7:50am. Grades 2-6 may line up on the black top near the bus yard at 7:50am. Please do not drop your child off prior to that as there is no adult supervision outside until 7:50am.

Breakfast begins at 7:30am. If you drop your child off for breakfast, they should come in through the bus yard doors where there is a designated staff member waiting to welcome them in and have them walk down the steps to the cafeteria for breakfast.

On Tuesday and Thursday mornings we have morning tutorial that begin at 7:35am. Doors will open at 7:30am. Please do not drop your children off prior to 7:30am. Please have students enter in through the bus yard doors. You must wait with your child until the school doors open at 7:30am.

Dismissal is at 2:25pm. Please make every effort to pick up your child on time. This is very important. If you are changing the way your child goes home in the afternoon, please be sure to put it in writing to the classroom teacher. This will help ensure that your child goes home by the correct form of transportation.

Please take time to read the Alden Terrace Parent Handbook as it contains important information for the 2019-2020 school year. Looking forward to a great year.
