\*\*Physical Exam required when student is a new entrant in either PK or Kindergarten, and all students in grades 1,3,5. The Physical Exam form must be provide to the School Nurse within 30 days from when your child starts school.

\* Dental certificates are requested, not required, at any time a physical examination is required

The chart illustrates the requirements of the Commisioner of Education Regulations - Health Service Part 136 and Elmont School District Policies.

The Physical Exam must be dated no more than 12 months prior to the start of the school year (date of entrance to the school) for new entrants.



New York State Education Law requires that students receive vision, hearing and scoliosis screening as part of the school health services provided by each public school district. The purpose of this requirement is to detect the presence of problems likely to impede a student's learning.

Elmont School District will be conducting vision and hearing screening starting in October of each school year. Classes will be scheduled for the screening as the school year progresses. Scoliosis screening is performed by a Registered Nurse. Parent notification for scoliosis screening is sent home prior to the scheduled screening. If the results of any screening indicates that your child requires further follow-up, you will receive written notification.
