PARENT RIGHT TO KNOW

Dear Parent or Guardian:

The School receives federal funds for Title I, Part A programs. Throughout the school year, we provide important information about this law and your child's education. This letter is to inform you about your right to request information about the qualifications of the staff working with your child.

You have the right to request information regarding the professional qualifications of your child's teacher(s). If you request this information, the district or school will provide you with answers to the following questions:

QUESTIONS

Q1. Has your child's teacher met state licensing requirements for the grade level and subject in which the teacher is providing instruction?

A1. All of your child's teachers are highly qualified and meet the New York State licensing requirements for the grade level and subject in which they are providing instruction.

Q2. What are the college degree majors and the fields of discipline for any graduate degrees or certificates the teacher holds?

A2. Information is available upon request. Please contact Mr. Kenneth Rosner, Director of Curriculum and Instruction at 516 326 5500, ext. 42022

Q3. If teaching under emergency status: is the teacher working under an emergency status for which state licensing requirements have been waived?

*A3. There are **NO** Elmont teachers providing instruction under emergency status. The District is required to notify you if your child's teacher is teaching under emergency status.*

You also have the right to request information regarding the professional qualifications of the paraprofessional(s) assisting your child's teacher(s). If you request this information, the district or school will provide you with answers to the following questions as soon as possible:

Q1. Is your child receiving Title I, Part A services from a paraprofessional?

*A1. Title I, Part A services are provided by highly qualified teachers and meet the New York State licensing requirements for the grade level and subject in which they are providing instruction. Title I services, Title I, Part A services are **NOT** provided by paraprofessionals.*

If at any time your student has been taught for four (4) or more consecutive weeks by a teacher(s) that is not highly qualified, you will be notified by the school.
